Mexico's epic capital is a fascinating hub of history and culture, where you'll never stop making fresh discoveries. There are countless theatres, museums and art galleries, or just watch the world go by at the floating gardens of Xochimilco. Treat your taste buds in elegant restaurants, or sample the electric atmosphere at the impressive Azteca football stadium.

Our Mexico City school is housed in an historic colonial building, close to many cosmopolitan restaurants and bars. There are six comfortable classrooms, a study, computer room, coffee lounge, kitchen and terrace areas, and a high-quality on-site residence. The Spanish classes, taught by friendly native teachers, have a maximum of just 9 students per class.
